

ACADEMIC CONCESSION REQUEST FORM

Read the <u>Law Academic Concessions webpage and procedures</u> before completing this form. Requests for academic concessions must be submitted to your Allard Law Advisor. Requests for academic concessions should be made promptly and must be made no later than 3 days after the due date for an assignment or paper, or a missed class. Where a student has received an approved extension of the due date for an assignment or paper, any concession requests for further extensions of the due date must be made in advance of the approved extension due date. Requests for an academic concession with respect to an exam (such as a request to defer an exam) must be made in advance of the start time of the examination. Requests for an exam to be rescheduled due a religious conflict or for First Nations, Métis, or Inuit students of Canada, a cultural observance, are due no later than the last day to add a course for that term.
